

Fiddler's Green Art Show Guidelines

Fiddler's Green is pleased to host a variety of works in our Art Show—especially works fitting Sandman's themes or relating to the work of the CBLDF. Other art will be displayed on a space available basis.

Commission structure:

Final sale price	Commission
\$99 or less	9%
\$100-249	12%
\$250-499	15%
\$500 or more	20% and a big round of applause

Artists who wish to donate works for the benefit of the CBLDF are welcome to do so (thanks in advance!) Please contact us at artists@fiddlersgreencon.org to make the necessary arrangements.

Our pricing structure will include several options:

- Minimum Bid (Minimum price a potential buyer may offer prior to the auction. Preferably \$5 or more.)
- After Auction Price (Optional: If desired, the artist may designate a price at which their work may be sold after the Voice Auction, if it had not sold by that point.)
- In addition, work may be exhibited for display only, and will be marked "Not For Sale." It is possible some work may be submitted with the intent that it is only available for sale at the voice auction, and will be marked "Direct To Auction."
- Please note that we are not offering works for Quick Sale at this show.

All prices will be posted in whole dollars; all bids submitted must likewise be in whole dollars.

We welcome originals or prints (signed & numbered please). It is understood that the artist is solely responsible for the ethical and legal issues surrounding the work they submit, including (but not limited to) the intellectual property rights of other artists. Artists understand that Fiddler's Green will take all due care to protect the art entrusted to us and will exercise reasonable best practices to safeguard our operations.

Artists are requested and encouraged to advise the convention at artists@fiddlersgreencon.org as soon as they have some idea of how much work they will be sending in. Please feel free to submit advance copies of control sheets to us prior to shipping the actual art.

We will also be operating a Print Shop for works coming in multiple copies. Further details can be found by contacting the Art Show at artists@fiddlersgreencon.org.

Artists not attending the convention, who are sending their work with an Agent, must provide us with a letter authorizing that Agent. Without your permission in writing, we cannot turn over your art or check to someone else on Sunday. An Agent Form is available for download for your use, if desired.

In order to facilitate processing of art prior to the convention, any work being mailed to us should be timed to arrive by Friday, 1 November 2004. Sending work sooner is not only fine, but appreciated. We will be shipping everything back via UPS during the week after the convention. (If you desire a different shipping method, please contact us to make those arrangements).

Commission checks will be mailed out by Friday, 17 December, 2004. As usual, if you have timing challenges or special needs, please don't hesitate to let us know.
